**The Program**] This program sponsored by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) aims at providing opportunities for Graduate /Undergraduate Students to strengthen the holistic capacities as humans, researchers, and/or social entrepreneurs, by learning natural/social/human linkages through the fieldwork and collaborative works in Yakushima and the UNESCO Chair WENDI professors from different graduate schools in Kyoto University.
